

# **Updates: Index Development**

- Validation Analyses
  - Candidate Measures for Moving Across Domains/Subdomains
  - Candidate Measures for Discontinuing (infrequently updated, low item-to-scale correlation, no variation across states, composite measures)
- Call for Measures
  - Elicited ~50-60 New Measures
    - RWJF Culture of Health Metrics (Inter-sectoral, Community Engagement)
    - Joint Commission on Accreditation of Health Care Organizations Compliance with Emergency Management Accreditation Standards
    - Measures of Social, Economic, Environmental, and Infrastructure Preparedness and Resiliency from the National Institute of Standards and Technology
    - Worksite and Occupational Health Measures of Preparedness and Resiliency
    - Fatality Management
- Expert Panel/Delphi Process
  - Measures, Subdomains, Domains
  - Weighting for "All-Hazards" Approach



# **Updates: Use, Usability, & Usefulness Survey**

- Purpose: to inform website, communication tools, and message development
- Survey Instrument Development Nearly Complete
  - Includes validated items from Technology Acceptance Model
- Pilot with Workgroups and National Advisory Committee
- Field Full Survey with Larger Set of Stakeholders
  - Public Health (e.g., state & local preparedness directors)
  - Emergency Management (county, state, & federal levels)
  - Preparedness Coalitions/Hospital Preparedness Program (reaching hospitals, CBOs, and businesses)
  - Preparedness Researchers (including CDC PRCS, Sandy, NIH Disaster Research Response Environmental Health Network, etc.)


